MISSION STATEMENT



Cabrini Mission Foundation responds with boldness, urgency and courage to the unmet needs of the most vulnerable and those on the margins of society. We support charitable works of healing, teaching and caring that reflect the charism of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, founded by **St. Frances Xavier Cabrini**. With every response we foster hope as bearers of the love of Christ in the world.

WHO WE ARE

Established in 1998, **Cabrini Mission Foundation** exists to respond to society's needs by supporting programs of healing, teaching, and caring sponsored by the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (MSC), the international religious order founded by St. Frances Xavier Cabrini in 1880.

JUBILEE 2025

A Year of Hope and New Beginnings



At the start of 2025, a year-long celebration of renewal and forgiveness was held for the Jubilee – a Catholic holy year that takes approximately every 25 years. Hosted in Rome, Italy, the Jubilee invites Catholics to partake in:

Pilgrimages – Visit Holy sites in Italy, and the Vatican, to develop a stronger connection with your faith.

Spiritual Rituals – Opening of the Holy Doors, mass, confessions, and processions.

Indulgence – Asking for the forgiveness of sins for themselves and loved ones.

Facts on the Jubilee:

- The first Catholic Jubilee was declared in 1300 by Pope Boniface VIII.
- Initially celebrated every 100 years, the interval shortened to 50, then 25 years.
- The Holy Doors, which are typically closed, are open exclusively during Jubilee years.
- The Jubilee is filled with many spiritual activities, cultural experiences and other festivities.
- These events will highlight many different groups of individuals within the church.
- The Jubilee ended on January 6th, 2026.

It is important to note that one did not have to be present in Italy to celebrate the Jubilee. Catholics were encouraged to use this time to reflect and become more grounded in their faith and relationship with God.

CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION PARTNERS WITH GIVE LIVELY Non-Profit Donation Processing Platform



In 2025, Cabrini Mission Foundation transitioned from Blackbaud's Raisers Edge to **Give Lively**, a comprehensive donation platform reimagining the way donors give. Give Lively will function as our donation processor, accepting one-time and/or monthly donations, event tickets and sponsorships. The data collected will be stored in Salesforce where staff can access records of all donors.

Launched in the second half of the year, Give Lively has offered the Foundation a multitude of ways to give, including peer-to-peer fundraising, text-to-donate, and, most importantly, a donor-facing payment page that is easy to use and condenses the payment process compared to our previous processor. Since launching Give Lively, the Foundation has received positive feedback. The Foundation hopes to reach new audiences and donors through the use of Give Lively.

The transition, though challenging, offered the foundation a modern approach to giving. The old data stored on Raisers Edge has now been downloaded and stored on our internal servers for easy access when needed.

#GIVINGTUESDAY 2025 Report

On **December 2, 2025**, Cabrini Mission Foundation participated in **#GivingTuesday**, a global movement taking place on the Tuesday following Thanksgiving of each year that encourages individuals to donate to a cause of their choice. The Foundation participated in the event by posting across all social platforms (X (formerly Twitter), Facebook, Instagram & LinkedIn), sending a carefully crafted e-blast, and posting campaign materials on the home page of the Foundation website. The strategy encouraged increased visibility and easy giving.

In preparation for the giving event, the Foundation increased its email audience by **630%** as part of the transition to **Givelively**. Moving forward, the Foundation will use this list for all newsletters and fundraising campaigns.

E-BLAST HIGHLIGHTS

- The e-blast was successfully sent to **16,786** recipients.
- The Foundation raised over **\$10,000** during the campaign.

In addition to Giving Tuesday, modern philanthropists had an opportunity to participate in **#CryptoGivingTuesday**, which highlighted giving through cryptocurrency. The foundation also participated in this movement by posting on X to ensure all core audiences were reached for optimized giving through **The Giving Block**. The post received great engagement from industry leaders.

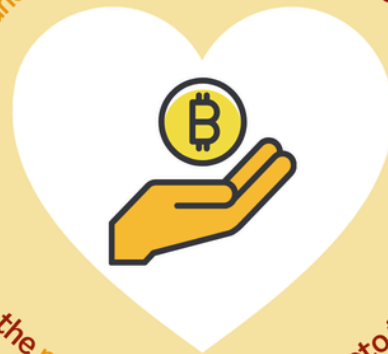

CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION AWARDS 2024/2025 EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS



The Cabrini Mission Foundation welcomed 2025 by awarding tuition scholarships for the 2024/2025 school year. This year, eight students from four different schools across New York State were selected to receive tuition assistance.

To qualify, students completed an application process that included submitting an essay about Mother Cabrini. This initiative is part of the Foundation's ongoing effort to celebrate Mother Cabrini's legacy in New York and her commitment to the education of the heart.

One of the scholarship recipients shared their thoughts:

“A Catholic school education, as valuable as it is, can be a financial struggle for many, especially single mothers. Mother Cabrini’s love and dedication to humanity and education highlight her vision of hope and improvement for young people. Her legacy shows that she believed every child could reach their full potential, become leaders, and develop critical thinking skills, regardless of their circumstances. I understand why she felt the world was too small for her mission. A woman who devoted her life to helping others is exactly what the world needs today. Love, hope, and faith. I’m grateful that even after her passing, her legacy continues, and this scholarship is proof that I am one of the many young students benefiting from someone who cared for others.”

The Foundation's scholarship application window opens each September through Thanksgiving with awards announced at the end of December. The Foundation firmly believes education is a key to success and hopes this tuition assistance will help these students continue to excel in their academic pursuits.

CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION PARTNERS WITH NYPD FOR BACK-TO-SCHOOL COLLECTION

In keeping with our commitment to support underserved students, Cabrini Mission Foundation renewed its partnership with the NYPD Patrol Borough Brooklyn South School Safety Division, Community Affairs Unit, and Brooklyn South Command to provide 50 backpacks to be filled with school supplies to children across the borough.



The backpacks were distributed throughout multiple school districts as part of a larger effort to ensure students begin the academic year fully prepared. Education remains a core mission of the Foundation, and through initiatives like this, we work to ensure that every child has the tools they need to succeed—both in the classroom and beyond.



CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION PARTNERS WITH DEL CAMINO JESUIT BORDER MINISTRIES TO CONTINUE EFFORTS AT U.S.-MEXICO BORDER

Since 2020, the Cabrini Mission Foundation has partnered with local organizations and faith-based groups to support immigrants at the U.S.-Mexico border. Our efforts have primarily focused on providing essential supplies—food, water, clothing, and toiletries—to uphold the dignity of those on the move.

In 2025, the U.S.-Mexico border remained closed to those without passports or visas. The repeated opening and closing of the border with each new administration highlights the deep flaws in our immigration system.

The partnership was with Del Camino Jesuit Border Ministries, a Jesuit-led initiative. Their name, meaning “of the way,” is inspired by Nuestra Señora del Camino (Our Lady of the Way). Many migrants turn to the Virgin Mary in prayer, and this devotion was especially significant to St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits.

Together, we continue to pray for her intercession, asking for protection and guidance for all those on their migrant journey.



CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION SUPPORTS VICTIMS OF LOS ANGELES FIRES

The Cabrini Mission Foundation continued its commitment to helping in the face of a natural disaster by donating \$5,000 to the Daughters of Charity working in California. This contribution aided their efforts in supporting victims of the devastating Los Angeles fires, providing essential assistance to those in need.

The Foundation has a long history of responding to natural disasters, from volcanoes to floods to fires, we pride ourselves in connecting locally to offer aid and support to affected communities. A few years ago, the Foundation extended support to those impacted by the Paradise, California fires, helping a church rebuild.

Through this donation, the Cabrini Mission Foundation was happy to partner with the Daughters of Charity, safeguarding that those affected by the fires receive the necessities they need to rebuild their lives.



CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION PROVIDES FLOOD RELIEF EFFORTS IN KERRVILLE, TEXAS

Cabrini Mission Foundation partnered with Notre Dame Catholic Church in Kerrville, Texas, in the aftermath of the devastating flash flood that had shaken their community. Tragically, 121 individuals—many of them children under the age of 10—were confirmed deceased, and approximately 170 remained missing, including campers, counselors, and workers.

Hundreds of first responders—from local, state, and federal agencies—along with volunteers, worked tirelessly in the ongoing search and rescue efforts.

In the face of this tragedy, churches across the area, including Notre Dame, opened their doors as places of refuge, prayer, and healing for grieving families and all those who were affected.



CELEBRATING OUR 2025 GALA HONOREES



Each year, the Cabrini Mission Foundation Gala brings together our extended Cabrini family for an evening of gratitude, joy, and hope. More than just a fundraiser, our Gala feels like a reunion—a chance to celebrate community, reconnect with friends, and honor those whose lives and service embody Mother Cabrini’s mission.

In 2025, we were proud to recognize three honorees whose faith, generosity, and dedication inspire us all: **His Eminence Timothy Cardinal Dolan, Felix and Francesca Avitabile (posthumously), and Vincent Iannelli.**

His Eminence Timothy Cardinal Dolan

For nearly two decades, Cardinal Dolan has shepherded the people of New York with his characteristic warmth, humor, and steadfast devotion to the Church. Appointed Archbishop of New York in 2009 and elevated to the College of Cardinals in 2012, his leadership has touched countless lives, not only in our Archdiocese but across the world. From his boyhood sense of vocation in St. Louis to his nearly 50 years of priestly service, Cardinal Dolan’s life reflects unwavering faith. He has also shown a deep affection for Mother Cabrini and her mission. As Sr. Pietrina shared during his introduction, the Cardinal warmly received a relic of our foundress shortly after becoming Cardinal of New York, beginning a friendship that continues to this day. His presence and support have been a blessing, and this year we joyfully honored him for his lifetime of service to God’s people.

The story of Felix and Francesca is, at its heart, a love story rooted in faith and family. They met in Italy just after World War II, when Felix, a young American soldier, traveled overseas to visit relatives. Francesca joined him in Brooklyn in 1947, where they married and built a life grounded in hard work, devotion, and hospitality. Though neither had the benefit of higher education, they sacrificed tirelessly so that their children could pursue their dreams. Their home became a beacon of welcome for friends, neighbors, and strangers alike. Among their four children, their daughter Sr. Antonina answered the call to religious life as a Missionary Sister of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, carrying forward their legacy of service. Even after their passing—Felix in 2018 and Francesca in 2020—their generosity continues. In 2024, the sale of the family’s Brooklyn home resulted in a transformative gift to the Cabrini Mission Foundation, ensuring their values of faith, family, and community will benefit generations to come.

Vincent Iannelli

A true builder of both structures and community, Vincent Iannelli represents the strength of tradition and the power of service. Beginning as a teenager working alongside his father and uncle in the family’s construction business, Vincent rose with his brother Tom to lead Iannelli Construction, one of New York’s premier public works contractors. Yet beyond the buildings he has helped raise, Vincent has built a life rooted in family, faith, and generosity. For over fourteen years, he has served as a trustee of the Cabrini Mission Foundation, offering both leadership and vision. His service extends far beyond Cabrini, including a number of roles he has held with other community organizations. His dedication, integrity, and commitment to community embody Mother Cabrini’s spirit of service.

Together, these honorees remind us of what it means to live out Mother Cabrini’s legacy—with faith, hope, and love. We are blessed to count them as part of our Cabrini family and grateful for the ways their lives continue to “make hope” in our world.

CABRINI MISSION FOUNDATION CONTINUES ITS PARTNERSHIP WITH SANT'EGIDIO

Cabrini Mission Foundation, in collaboration with Cabrini Immigrant Services – NYC, has continued its partnership with Community of Sant'Egidio, a global Christian movement of volunteer communities focused on service to the poor, have helped to distribute 400 meals weekly to the homeless population in New York City. Volunteers and supporters work in tandem to provide individuals in need with a hot meal, a friendly smile, and an opportunity for a long-term relationship.

To establish a meaningful connection with those who come for help, Sant'Egidio's members exceed expectations, and accompany these individuals on apartment viewings and social security meetings, while following up on various social services. In addition to food resources, Sant'Egidio has partnered with Power in a Shower to provide mobile shower services to those who are in search of access to basic hygienic needs.

MEXICO AND UNITED STATES BORDER INITIATIVES

Cabrini Mission Foundation, in partnership with Angry Tias & Abuelas of the Rio Grande Valley, Pastor Abraham Barberi of One Mission Ministries, Casa Migrante San Juan Diego Y San Francisco de Asis A.C, as well as Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley, continued to sponsor the operations of a number of shelters for asylum seekers in Matamoros and Reynoso Mexico. To date, Cabrini Mission Foundation has provided funds for the building of a well, toilets, a septic system, shelter from the sun, as well as a commercial refrigerator and freezer. Despite not having a physical presence at the border, Cabrini Mission Foundation has maintained a proactive approach to helping immigrants.

MENTAL HEALTH AND NUTRITIONAL PROGRAM

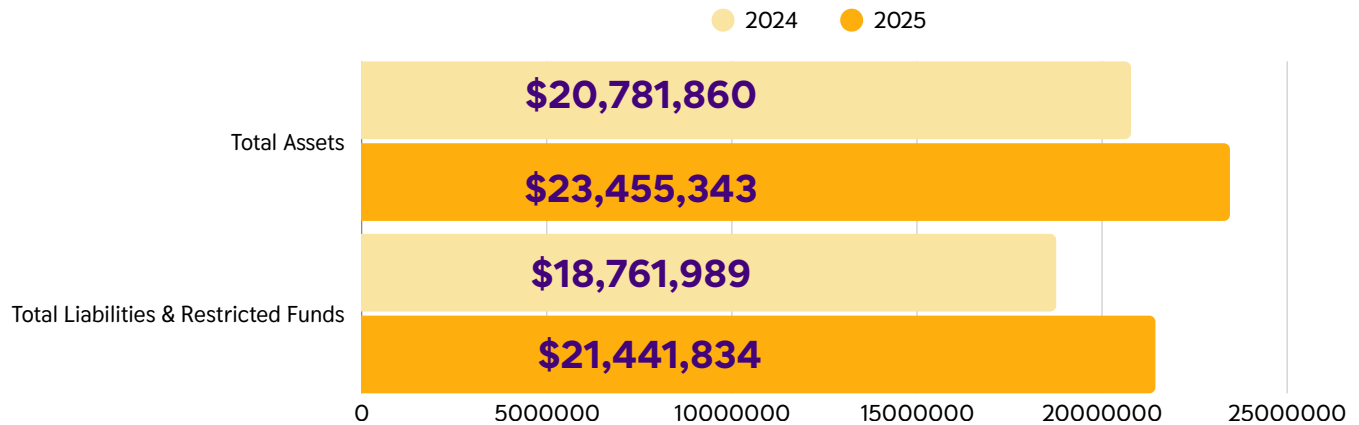
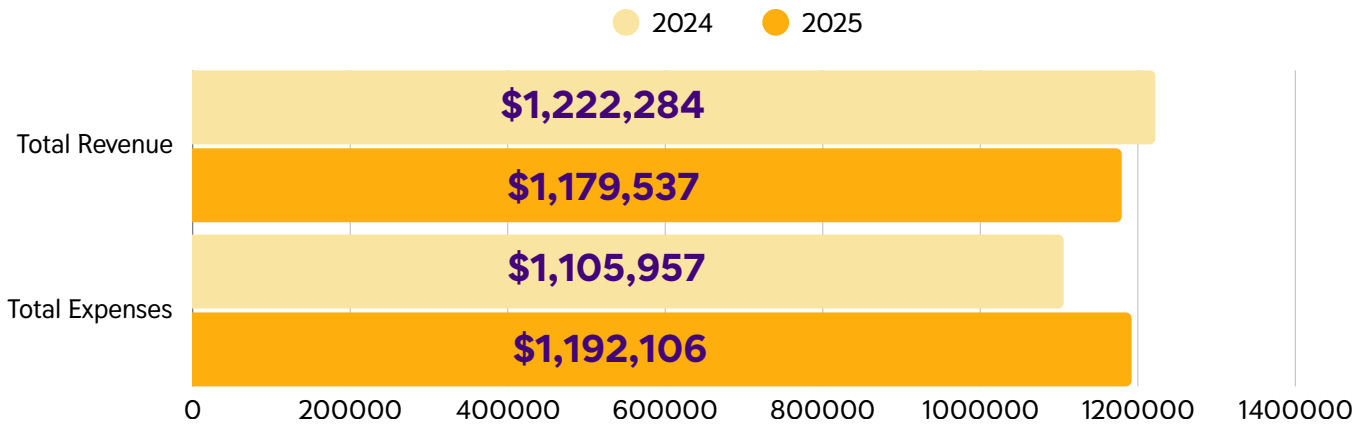
